Opinion

1. We have audited the accompanying statement of Quarterly and Year-to-date Consolidated Financial Results of **Sunrakshakk Industries India Limited (Formerly Known as A.K. Spintex Limited)** ("the Holding Company") and its subsidiary (the Holding Company and its subsidiary together referred to as "the Group"), for the quarter ended 31st March, 2026 and the year-to-date results for the period from 1st April 2025 to 31st March 2026, (the "Statement"), attached herewith, being submitted by the Holding Company pursuant to the requirement of the Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended (the "LODR Regulations").

2. In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us, the Financial Results:
 - (i) includes the financial results of the following subsidiary:
 - Sunrakshak Agro Products Pvt Ltd (Wholly Owned Subsidiary)

 - (ii) are presented in accordance with the requirements of Regulation 33 of the LODR Regulations, and;

 - (iii) gives a true and fair view in conformity with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in the applicable Indian Accounting Standards ("Ind AS") and other accounting principles generally accepted in India of the net profit, other comprehensive income and other financial information of the Company for the quarter ended 31st March, 2026 and the year-to-date results for the period from 1st April, 2025 to 31st March, 2026.

Basis for Opinion

3. We conducted our audit in accordance with the Standards on Auditing (“SA’s”) specified under Section 143(10) of the Companies Act, 2013, (“the Act”). Our responsibilities under those SAs are further described in the “Auditors’ Responsibilities for the Audit of the Consolidated Financial Results” section of our report. We are independent of the of the Group, in accordance with the Code of Ethics issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India (“the ICAI”) together with the ethical requirements that are relevant to our audit of the Consolidated financial statements under the provisions of the Act and the Rules thereunder, and we have fulfilled our other ethical responsibilities in accordance with these requirements and the Code of Ethics. We believe that the audit evidence obtained by us is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion on the Consolidated Financial Results.

Mangement’s Responsibilities for the Consolidated Financial Results

4. The Statement has been prepared on the basis of the Consolidated annual financial statements.

The Holding Company’s Management and its Board of Directors are responsible for the preparation and presentation of the Statement that gives a true and fair view of the net profit and other comprehensive income of the Holding Company and other financial information of the Group in accordance with the recognition and measurement principal laid down in Ind AS 34, ‘Interim Financial Reporting’ prescribed under Section 133 of the Act read with relevant rules issued thereunder and other accounting principles generally accepted in India and in compliance with Regulations 33 of the Listing Regulations. The respective Management and Board of Directors of the companies included in the Group is responsible for maintenance of adequate accounting records in accordance with the provisions of the Act for safeguarding the assets of their respective companies and for preventing and detecting frauds and other irregularities; selection and application of appropriate accounting policies; making judgements and estimates that are reasonable and prudent; and the design, Implementation and maintenance of adequate internal financial controls that were operating effectively for ensuring accuracy and completeness of the accounting records, relevant to the preparation and presentation of the Statement that give a true and fair view and are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error, which have been used for the purpose of preparation of the Statement by the Directors of the Holding Company, as aforesaid.

5. In preparing the Statement, the Management and the Board of Directors of the Companies included in the Group are responsible for assessing the ability of Group to continue as a going concern, disclosing, as applicable, matters related to going concern and using the going concern basis of accounting unless the respective Board of Directors either intends to liquidate or to cease operations, or has no realistic alternative but to do so.

The respective Board of Directors of the companies included in the Group are also responsible for overseeing the financial reporting process of the group.

Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Consolidated Financial Results

6. Our objectives are to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the Statement as a whole is free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error, and to issue an auditor's report that includes our opinion. Reasonable assurance is a high level of assurance but is not a guarantee that an audit conducted in accordance with SAs will always detect a material misstatement when it exists. Misstatements can arise from fraud or error and are considered material if, individually or in aggregate, they could reasonably be expected to influence the economic decisions of users taken on the basis of this Statement.

As part of an audit in accordance with SAs, we exercise professional judgement and maintain professional skepticism throughout the audit. We also:

- Identify and assess the risks of material misstatement of the Statement, whether due to fraud or error, design and perform audit procedures responsive to those risks, and obtain audit evidence that is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion. The risk of not detecting a material misstatement resulting from fraud is higher than for one resulting from error, as fraud may involve collusion, forgery, intentional omissions, misrepresentations, or the override of internal control.

If we conclude that a material uncertainty exists, we are required to draw attention in our auditor's report to the related disclosures in the Statement or, if such disclosures are inadequate, to modify our opinion. Our conclusions are based on the audit evidence obtained upto the date of our auditor's report. However, future events or conditions may cause the Company to cease to continue as a going concern.

- Obtain sufficient appropriate audit evidence regarding the the Statement of the Group Companies included herein to express an opinion on the financial results.
7. Materiality is the magnitude of misstatement in Consolidated Financial Results, that individually or in aggregate, makes it probable that the economic decisions of a reasonably knowledgeable user of the financial results may be influenced. We consider quantitative materiality and qualitative factors in (i) planning the scope of our audit work and in evaluating the results of our work; and (ii) to evaluate the effect of any identified misstatements in the Consolidated Financial Results.
 8. We communicate with those charged with governance regarding, among other matters, the planned scope and timing of the audit and significant audit findings, including any significant deficiencies in internal control that we identify during our audit.
 9. We also provide those charged with governance with a statement that we have complied with relevant ethical requirements regarding independence, and to communicate with them all relationships and other matters that may reasonably be thought to bear on our independence, and where applicable, related safeguards.
 10. We also performed procedures in accordance with the Circular No. CIR/CFD/CMD1/44/2019 dated March 29, 2019 issued by the Securities Exchange Board of India under Regulation 33(8) of the Listing Regulations, to the extent applicable.

Other Matters

- a) The Consolidated Financial Statement includes the audited financial results/ statements and other financial information, in respect of subsidiary “**Sunrakshak Agro Products Pvt Ltd**” being audited by other Auditors, whose Financial results/ statements include (before consolidation) total assets of Rs. 10749.96 Lakhs as at 31st March, 2026, total revenue of Rs. 90.86 Lakhs and Rs. 39417.73 Lakhs for the quarter and year ended on that date respectively considered in the consolidated Financial Result.

Our opinion on the Consolidated financial results is not modified in respect of the above matters.

This Financial information have been audited by other auditors whose report have been furnished to us by the management and our opinion on the statement, in so far as it relates to the amounts and disclosures included in respect of this subsidiary, is solely based on the respective reports of other auditor and procedures performed by us as stated under auditors’ responsibilities section above.

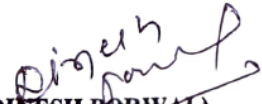
